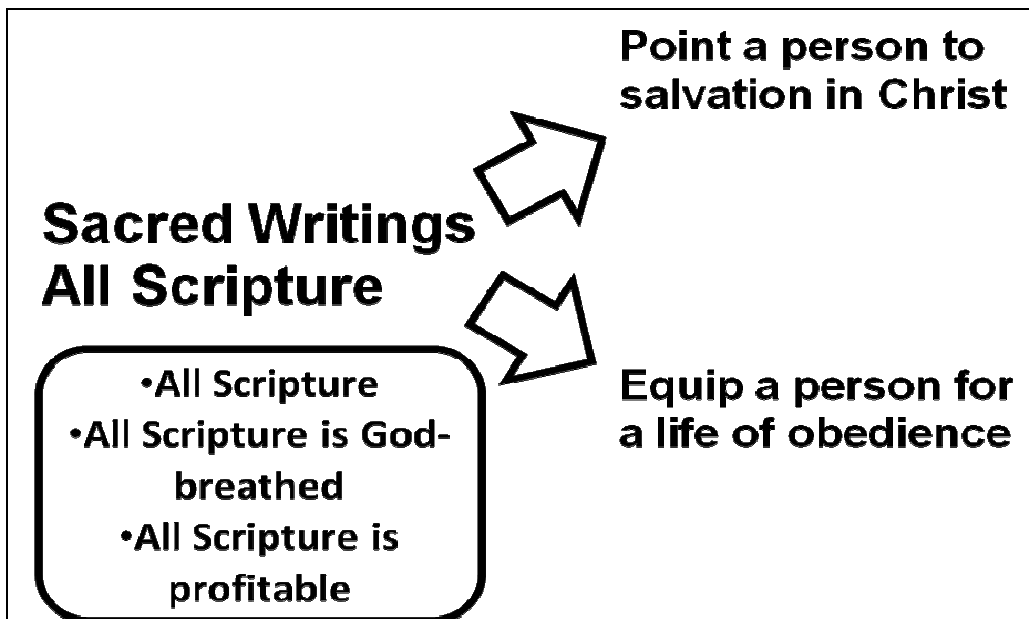
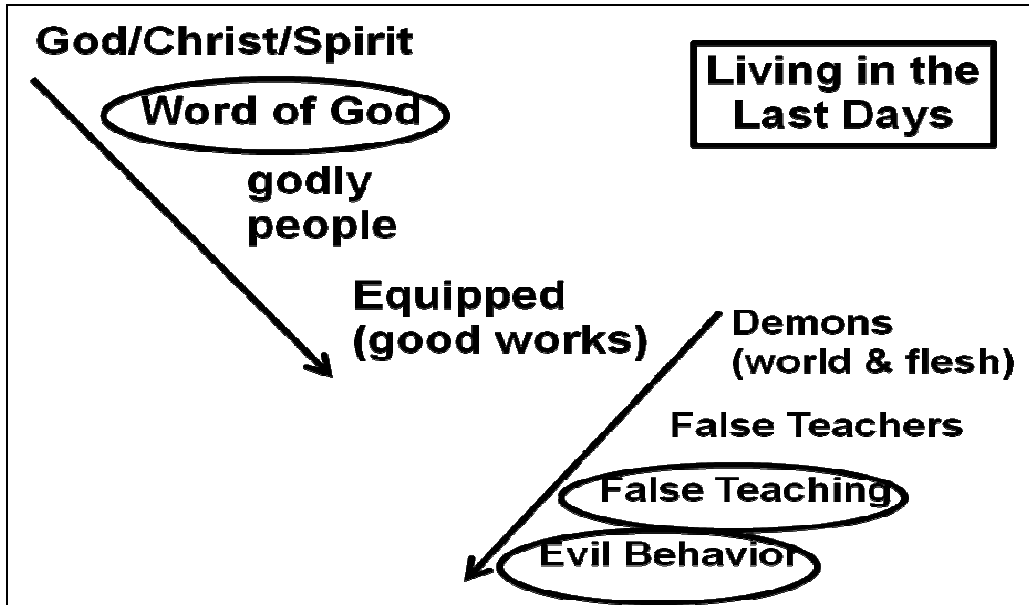


**“God’s Word is True”
2 Timothy 3:16-17 and 2 Peter 1:20-21**

The Bible

Therefore, it is to be believed in all that it teaches, obeyed in all that it requires, and trusted in all that it promises.

- **As the verbally inspired Word of God** (2 Tim. 3:16; 2 Pet. 1:20,21), **the Bible is without error in the original writings** (Num. 23:19; 2 Sam. 7:28; Prov. 30:5; Ps. 119:96, 160; Matt. 5:18; Jn. 10:35; 17:17; Tit. 1:1,2)”
- What questions come to your mind? What principles have you discovered that you can put into practice? Share with a friend what you are working on in your life.

Friday-Saturday

- Look up the following verses for each of the statements.
- **As the verbally inspired Word of God** (2 Tim. 3:16; 2 Pet. 1:20,21), **the Bible is . . . the complete revelation of His will for salvation** (Lk. 16:29-31; Gal. 1:8,9; 2 Tim. 3:15).
