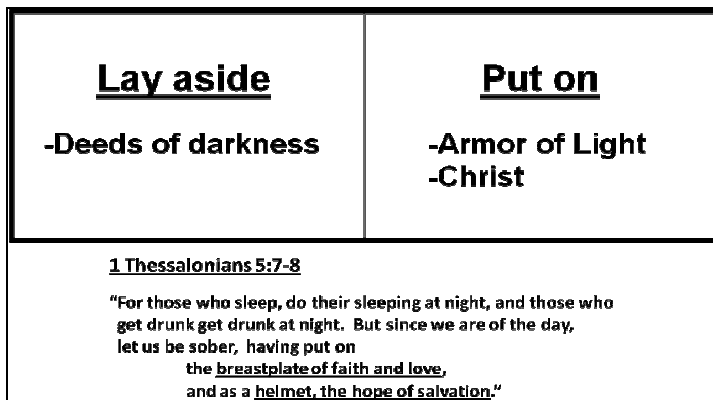
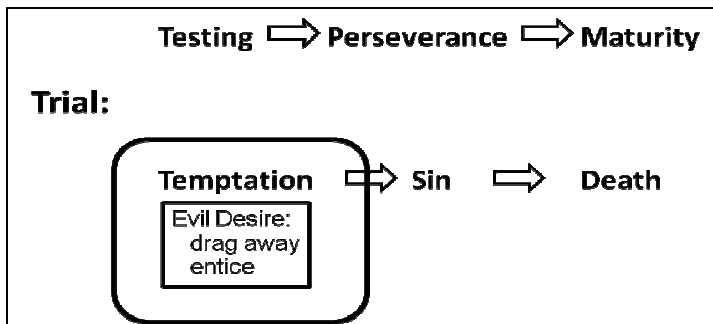
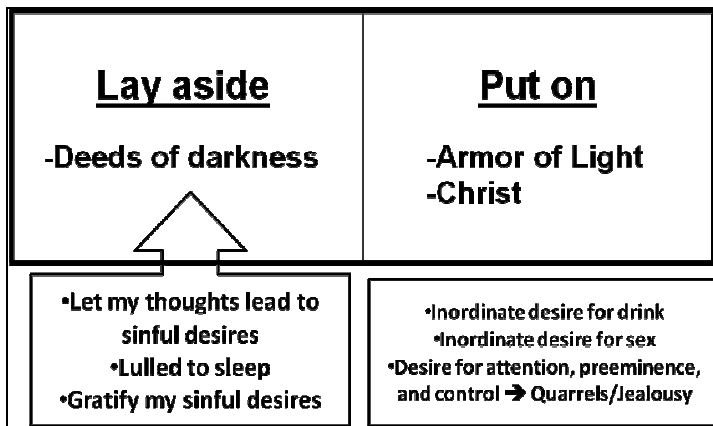


**Transformed Living: “How I’m Becoming Like Jesus”
Romans 13:11-14**

Romans 13:11-14

- ¹¹ Besides this you know the time, that the hour has come for you to wake from sleep. For salvation is nearer to us now than when we first believed.
- ¹² The night is far gone; the day is at hand. So then let us cast off the works of darkness and put on the armor of light.
- ¹³ Let us walk properly as in the daytime, not in orgies and drunkenness, not in sexual immorality and sensuality, not in quarreling and jealousy.
- ¹⁴ But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh, to gratify its desires.

See Ephesians 5:7-14 and 1 Thessalonians 5:4-8.



Day by Day in the Word

“Day by Day in the Word” is a tool we use to help in the transformation process in which the Spirit of God uses the Word of God to bring about Christlikeness.

Monday-Tuesday

- Let’s walk with Jesus through His last week today. Jesus arrived in Bethany six days before the Passover to spend time with His friends, Mary, Martha, and Lazarus. Read this in John 12:1-11. See also Matthew 26:6-13; Mark 14:3-9; (Luke 7:36-39). What took place at this dinner? How were people responding?
- The next day was the Sabbath and nothing is mentioned in the Gospels.
- Read the Triumphal Entry in Matthew 21:1-11; Mark 11:1-11; Luke 19:28-44; and John 12:12-19. What actually happened at the event? What did it mean? See Zechariah 9:9 and Psalm 118:25-26.
- Spend time today meditating on who Jesus is and what He did.

Wednesday-Thursday

- Let’s walk with Jesus through His last week today. Jesus cleared the temple on Monday. Read about this event in Matthew 21:10-17; Mark 11:15-18; Luke 19:45-48. What did Jesus find happening in the temple? Why did He clear the temple?
- Tuesday was a day of controversy for Jesus and a day in which He taught in parables. See these events in Matthew 21:23-24:51; Mark 11:27-13:37; Luke 20:1-21:36. What did He predict about the temple? What did the disciples learn about His return? What importance does this have, especially being shared during the last few days of His life?
- There was probably another day of rest on Wednesday. See Mark 14:1; John 12:1.
- Read about the Passover, which took place on Thursday, in Matthew 26:17-30; Mark 14:12-26; Luke 22:7-23; John 13:1-30. What do you learn about the Lord’s Supper?
- Spend time today meditating on who Jesus is and what He did.

Friday-Saturday

- Let’s walk with Jesus through His last week today. On Friday, the Crucifixion took place. Read about it in Matthew 27:1-66; Mark 15:1-47; Luke 22:66-23:56; John 18:28-19:37. What events took place leading up to the crucifixion? What were the final words of Jesus on the Cross and what did they mean?
- Jesus was placed in the tomb before 6:00 p.m. Friday night.
- The Resurrection took place on Sunday, read about it in Matthew 28:1-13; Mark 16:1-20; Luke 24:1-49; John 20:1-31.
- How does walking with Jesus in His last days impact your life? How does it impact your prayer life? How does it impact your worship? How does it impact your life of reaching the world? Spend time with the Lord today, praising Him for who He is and what He has done in your life.
